**THE CLERGY AND THE SEXUAL
REVOLUTION**

Lord's crucified body." So starts the article by Philip Trower in the 9/23/10 issue of *The Wanderer*. Why is the Catholic Church being singled out about sexual sins? "Sexual seduction of the young by older men and women, homosexual or heterosexual alike, like the other capital sins, we can assume are all but as old as Adam and Eve. Has the Church altered its teaching about sinfulness of any kind of sexual intercourse outside of marriage? No. Why, then, are Church laws no longer effective? Because there has been a profound cultural change inimical to the natural law and the Church's teaching on human sexuality..."

"And who has been responsible for this change? Who else surely if not the sexual revolutionaries of the fifties and sixties and their successors? ... They are the ones who are responsible for the age of sexual consent being lowered, for the press and media being packed with sexual stimulation material, for younger and younger children being given more and more explicit sex education, and now for putting the Church and other faith communities under pressure to employ "gays" as ministers of religion. They are also the ones responsible for advancing 'liberal' psychological theories which deny or minimize the evil of illicit sexual contacts -- the same theories which postconciliar bishops put their faith in disastrously, when it led them to have abusive priests 'treated' privately rather than exposing, removing, and punishing them. In this respect I would say there is a good case for considering the sexual revolutionaries as equally if not more guilty than the priests whose terrible sins and crimes have recently been coming to light. I would go even further. By eroticizing the whole of western culture to a degree unknown to history -- I suggest we can justly accuse them of 'sexually abusing' whole nations and generations."

Pope Benedict has also expressed his views on the scandals. "It is not enough to focus on the ill-will and injustice of our opponents, he said. 'Today we see in a really terrifying way that the greatest persecution of the Church does not come from forces outside, but is born from sin in the Church' with the implication, it seems that if enough of us had been living at the level we should have been, the scandals would *continued on p.2*

"Writing over and over about the clerical sexual abuse scandals is a bit like probing a wound in our

not have taken place or nothing like on the scale they have.”

“...There is always sin. The Devil never sleeps. But evil only gets a serious grip on the Church at a particular time when grace in the souls of the majority of the faithful is at a low level...But all of us -- victims, parents, and faithful Catholics generally -- must, I suggest, strive to achieve a more merciful forgiving frame of mind if the scandals are not to seriously jeopardize or destroy our spiritual life... This, it seems to me, we can best achieve if we reflect on the fact that no matter how much spiritual and psychological damage the victims have endured, the situation of the priests responsible is in the last resort far, far worse -- awe-inspiringly worse. When they die, they are going to have to answer to the Just Judge who said of those who harm His young, 'It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck and he were cast into the sea than that he should cause one of these little ones to sin' (Luke 17:2)... At least some good can come out of this tragedy if it makes us all more aware of how much the clergy are in the front line when it comes to the Devil's attacks, how much they need our prayers and mortifications, and that this is not just a nice pious idea, but a serious necessity. As the victims will find, there is nothing like praying for people who have wronged you for bringing peace to your own mind.”

BRIGHAM CONTINUES KILLING

In the August issue of this newsletter, we revealed how easily the notorious abortionist, Steven Brigham, was able to leave PA, supposedly for good. Now we find out he has a secret abortion mill, "Grace Medical Care," near Philly, and is being investigated by both New Jersey and Maryland for transporting patients for late term abortions from NJ to MD -- after the abortions were started in NJ. Brigham has never been licensed in MD yet has "mills" there. The corpses of 35 later-term babies were found at his Elkton, MD office when it was raided. Please write to the U.S. Attorney General's Office to get this creep finally stopped for good in *all* states and jailed for life.

Kay's Korner

For years, we've heard about secret societies including, among others, the Masons. The most secret and hard to penetrate was what is now referred to as the Bilderberg Group (B.G.). Recently, I borrowed a book entitled, *Jim Tucker's Bilderberg Diary*. Jim was a 25 year veteran journalist who managed to penetrate the meeting this group for the first time in 1954. His book was published in 2005 by American Free Press.

The consistent participants in this secret group included the Rockefellers, Rothschild's, bankers, heads of international corporation and high government officials from Europe and North America. Each year, a few new people are invited and, if found useful, they return to future meetings. This organization had its roots in 1908 with the early Rockefellers, etc. Why should we care? We should care because their efforts included population control, abortion, money control and manipulation of governments as part of their plans for "Utopia". As a pro-life activist in the 1980's I heard about the "New World Order." I had several books and articles, but decided to focus on abortion and euthanasia. However, recently I found an audio tape by a Canadian woman, Cornelia Ferreria. She used her words to describe the problem of the Age of Aquarius and its demonic base. But it could be useful for those of us who are discovering the process of "One World" domination. The secret group we're discussing was named by Jim because the first meeting he was able to penetrate was held at the Hotel de Bilderberg in Holland in 1954. In the December 3, 2004 obituary for Prince Bernard of the Netherlands, he was credited with establishing the Bilderberg Group - a secret annual discussion forum for prominent politicians, thinkers, and businessmen which he chaired from 1954-1976. Please keep in mind that the Logan Act prohibits private citizens from meeting in order to influence foreign policy. It prohibits private citizens from negotiating U.S. policy.

The *Trilateral Commission (T.C.)* was created in 1973 at the suggestion of David Rockefeller. At their meeting in the spring of 1984, The U.S. was blamed for the staggering debts of the 3rd world. Another bailout by the U.S. taxpayers. (No need to have international banks cut their crippling interest rates.) What's another Billion to Americans.

Next outpouring of taxpayer money was into the African Continent - as endorsed by Rockefeller, John Temple Swing and Robert McNamara. In 1987, the B.G. had as their goals for the U.S., higher taxes, to elect Bush, and spend more on NATO. In 1989, the B.G. was angry at Margaret Thatcher because she resisted surrendering national sovereignty to the European Union, so they were instructed to attack her politically so she would bend. Keep in mind that the B.G. long-time goal was to have the world divided into 3 groups: Europe, the Americas and Asian divisions under control of the United Nations. WOMEN...WHERE ARE YOUR CHILDREN?

Population survey, the past few days we have seen the analysis of women who are having (and not having) children. According to census Bureau's Current population Survey, the highest group of women on track for loneliness in their twilight years due to 'childlessness' are White women (20%). Not far behind comes Black and Hispanic women (17%) followed closely by Asian women (16%).

The author of this article, Megan Morris, refutes the analysis by D'Vera Cohn of the figures that have led women down the path of barrenness. Cohn states, "education seems to be a factor in a woman's choice to be a mother. The more educated women are, the higher the childless rate is." This comment is completely contradicted by some of the results which report that the childlessness rate has decreased for women with advanced degrees from 31% in 1994 to 24% in 2008.

"Unfortunately, what you do not see in this study is an analysis of the 'post contraceptive regret' that is prevalent among all ethnic groups of women. How do I know this? First hand testimony and Nursing experience... Over the years as a Registered Nurse, I experienced a steady pattern of women who shared their gut-wrenching stories of pain and sadness from their choice at a young age to not have children."

"It was not until recently that I have been able to fully grasp what was meant by Our Lord as he met the women of Jerusalem on the way to the Cross. 'Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me, but weep for yourselves and for your children. For behold, the days are coming when they will say, Blessed are the barren, and the wombs that never bore, and the breasts that never nursed!' "

"This is exactly what the media is saying to us when we are told, 'Women have more options than in the past to build strong careers and to exercise the choice not to have children.' More words of wisdom from D'Vera Cohn. Unfortunately, the current numbers on 'childlessness' account for those who bought into the myth that contraception and abortion would liberate them for an awesome career in a 'man's world.' It's time to ask them if giving up motherhood was well worth the fulfillment they were promised. 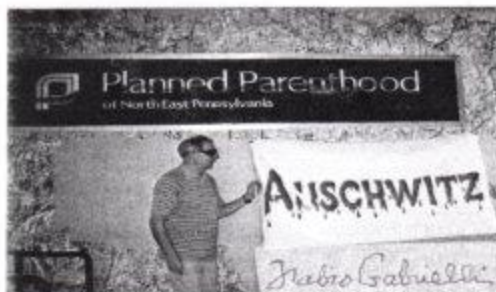
